

BY PARTICIPATING, YOU AGREE TO THESE OFFICIAL RULES, WHICH ARE A CONTRACT.

1. Sponsor. HavenHouse St. Louis (“HHSTL”) is the sponsor of The “Bourbon” Raffle (the “Raffle”). HHSTL is a 501(c)(3) non-profit organization. The purpose of the Raffle is to raise funds for the operation of HavenHouse St. Louis and for the related activities of HHSTL.

2. Raffle Overview. The Raffle begins on January 31, 2020 and ends on March 21, 2020, or when tickets are sold-out, whichever occurs first.

3. Eligibility. Any person 21 years of age or older, residing where the Raffle is not prohibited, may purchase a ticket (“Ticket”) to be entered in the Raffle (such person shall be herein known as the “Ticket Holder”). An affidavit of eligibility may be required from Ticket Holders who win a prize. HHSTL staff members and their immediate family members (in this instance known as spouses and children), are prohibited from purchasing Tickets.

4. Rules. By purchasing a Ticket, each Ticket Holder accepts and agrees to be bound by all the rules, limitations, conditions, and restrictions set forth herein (the “Rules”), as well as all applicable local, state, and federal laws and regulations. HHSTL’s decisions in all matters concerning the Raffle and its interpretation and application of the Rules shall be final. Please contact HHSTL if you have questions regarding the Rules or the Raffle. The Raffle is void where prohibited by law.

5. Releases. By purchasing a Ticket, each Ticket Holder releases HHSTL, its directors, officers, employees, and agents, from any and all liability with respect to the Raffle, including, but not limited to, the selection process and the interpretation and application of the Rules, and from any and all liability for injuries, losses, or damages of any kind caused by any prize or resulting from acceptance, possession, use, or misuse of any prize, and each Ticket Holder agrees to indemnify and hold HHSTL harmless from any and all losses, damages, rights, claims, and actions of any kind arising in connection with or as a result of the winner’s acceptance or use of any prize. Each Ticket Holder agrees that his/her name, likeness, and any statements made by him/her regarding the prize may be disclosed to, and used by, the news media and may otherwise be used by HHSTL for advertising or publicity purposes without compensation, and in lists of prize winners that may be published in area news publications and other media.

6. Tickets. **The cost to purchase a Ticket for the Raffle is \$100.00 (U.S. Funds only). A maximum of 150 Tickets will be sold.** Each Ticket has one number. Any eligible person may purchase more than one Ticket. Odds of winning depend on the number of valid Tickets sold. Tickets will not be sold after 9:00 p.m., Central Standard Time (“CST”), Saturday, March 21, 2020. Any unsold tickets become the property of HHSTL. Any ticket(s) purchased after the 150 limit has been reached but prior to HHSTL’s removal of the online order form will be invalid and the purchaser’s payment will be refunded. The IRS has taken the position that amounts paid for chances in raffles, lotteries, or similar drawings for valuable prizes are not gifts, and consequently do not qualify as deductible charitable contributions. **A Ticket is not valid and shall not be entered in the Raffle until full and satisfactory payment for such Ticket is received by HHSTL.** Tickets are not transferable once purchased.

7. Failure of Payment. If a Ticket Holder’s payment by credit card is declined or check is dishonored by the bank for any reason, such Ticket Holder’s Ticket shall be invalid and will not be entered in the drawing, unless full and satisfactory payment is made by 10:00 p.m. CST, Saturday, March 21, 2020. HHSTL will endeavor to notify the invalidated Ticket Holder by phone at the number provided on the ticket purchasing website; however, any failure to do so shall not cause the Ticket to become valid,

cause the Ticket to be entered in the Raffle, or give rise to any claim or cause of action on behalf of the invalidated Ticket Holder.

8. Multiple-Party Tickets. In the event that more than one name is listed on a Ticket, the first name listed shall be deemed to be the Ticket Holder. Delivery or payment of the prize shall be made to the Ticket Holder. It is the responsibility of the Ticket Holder to allocate any such prize among the participants in a multiple-party Ticket, and HHSTL, its directors, officers, employees, and agents, shall have no liability for any failure to do so.

9. Raffle Drawing. The Raffle Drawing shall take place on Monday, March 23, 2020 or sooner if all tickets are sold before March 21, 2020. In order to be eligible for the Raffle Drawing, a Ticket Holder must have purchased their Ticket online before 9:00 p.m. CST, Saturday, March 21, 2020. Fifteen (15) winning numbers will be randomly chosen, and the winner of each prize ("Winner") will be the Ticket Holder who has purchased a valid Ticket whose number matches the number chosen. The 1st Winner will have their choice of one (1) prize from the 15 available. The 2nd Winner will then have their choice of one (1) prize from the 14 remaining. This process will repeat until one (1) prize remains, which will be awarded to the 15th Winner. If the Raffle is held, all prizes will be awarded. If the Raffle is not held, all money will be returned to the Ticket Holders. There is no substitution of prizes. **TICKET HOLDERS NEED NOT BE PRESENT TO WIN.**

10. Notification of Winners: HHSTL shall notify each Winner of his/her assigned ordinal rank (1st, 2nd, 3rd...15th) within seven days of the drawing. Winning Ticket Holders will be notified by phone at the number **provided via website when purchasing the Ticket** (a "Winner Notification"). The names and order of the winners will also be available at HHSTL and online at www.HavenHousestl.org/HHSTLRaffle within seven days of the drawing.

11. Claiming a Prize. After receiving a Winner Notification, the 1st Winner will have 72 hours to notify HHSTL which prize he/she is selecting. Once the 1st Winner has selected a prize, HHSTL will notify the 2nd Winner of which prizes remain. Like the 1st Winner, the 2nd Winner and each subsequent Winner, once receiving a Winner Notification to choose a prize, will have 72 hours to notify HHSTL which prize he/she is selecting. Any Winner who fails to notify HHSTL within 72 hours after receiving a Winner Notification to choose a prize forfeits his/her right to select a prize: NO prize will be awarded the Ticket Holder; HHSTL will move forward with contacting the next Winner who may select from the remaining prizes, all subsequent Winners will advance one place in the list of Winners, and the next Ticket Holder named in the randomly ordered list of Ticket Holders will be notified as being the 15th Winner. Each Winner who notifies HHSTL of his/her selection within his/her allotted 72 hours has 30 days to retrieve the prize from HHSTL in Maryland Heights, MO, or such other location designated by HHSTL. **NO PRIZES WILL BE SHIPPED.** If a winner fails to claim and/or retrieve his/her prize from HHSTL within 30 days after being notified to choose a prize, HHSTL shall draw another ticket and award that prize to the new Winner. Prize cannot be redeemed for cash.

12. Obligations of Winning Ticket Holders. Except as otherwise provided herein, the Ticket Holder who wins the prize is responsible for all costs associated with such prize, including, but not limited to, registration, licensing, delivery and other applicable fees, as well as all local, state, and federal taxes that may be applicable. Ticket Holders are advised to consult with a tax advisor to determine any tax liabilities.
